The industry of the naturally coloured diamonds recognizes 13 colour varieties of diamonds. For any colour description of a diamond, the modifier is registered always at first, followed by the dominant hue. For example, brownish pink, or br-*PK*. If the modifying colour is more dominant, then the appellation will be brown-pink or BR-*PK*.
